### Spring 2007 Fees for Full-Time MBA, and Joint MBA/MPH Students

Spring 2007 fees have been assessed by the University and are available for viewing on BearFacts (click on “Registration” and then click on “Reg Fee Summary”). The fees for Full-Time MBA students and Joint MBA/MPH students are as follows:

	<u>Full-Time MBA</u>	<u>Joint MBA/MPH</u>
<i>California Residents:</i>	\$12,729.25	\$12,668.00
<i>Non-Residents:</i>	\$18,316.75	\$18,322.25

If you waived the health insurance fee during the fall semester, it will be automatically waived in the spring semester. If you didn't waive the health insurance fee in the fall and would like to do so for the spring, please contact the Student Health Insurance Office at (510) 642-5700, or complete the waiver form online at <https://app.uhs.berkeley.edu/waivers/waiverform.asp>.

E-Billing Statements will be generated around December 26<sup>th</sup>; you will receive an email notifying you that your fee statement is ready for viewing. Payment of spring fees is due by January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2007. As a reminder, you have the option of paying your bill in full or electing the Deferred Payment Plan (DPP), wherein your fees are paid in five equal monthly installments (due the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month—beginning with January 15<sup>th</sup> and ending with May 15<sup>th</sup>). There is a \$40 participation fee for utilizing the DPP, and it is assessed for each semester that you use the DPP.
