The above courses are open to both business majors and non-majors. However, during the regular academic year, enrollment priority is given to business majors and other students are enrolled on a space available basis starting from the beginning of the wait lists. It is common for these classes to have wait lists and for some students to be unable to enroll. During the summer, however, enrollment is open and classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Please remember that appropriate courses may be completed at UC Berkeley or at other colleges, but it is important that students check with their home department or college before enrolling in any non-UC Berkeley courses.
