Enrollment for Semester of Return to UC Berkeley and Haas:

All students not participating in EAP must complete an **Undergraduate Application for Readmission** and a **Statement of Legal Residence** form.

Please get the form at: <http://admissions.berkeley.edu/pdf/UndergraduateReadmissionApplication.pdf> and pay the applicable fee, then bring the completed form to the Haas Undergraduate Program Office in S450 Haas prior to going abroad.

**Unless this completed form is received and approved by Haas, you will not be able to enroll in classes for your return to UC Berkeley.**

After you have confirmed your international enrollment with Haas, your Tele-BEARS appointment times and Advisor Code will be sent via e-mail so you can enroll in courses for the semester of your return to Cal.

**It is important that you continue to use your CalMail e-mail account as that is where important information will be sent.**

### International Study Contract

**All Haas majors and applicants must meet with the Haas international study advisor to discuss final plans and sign this form prior to departure.**

“By my signature on this form, I agree to comply with all Haas, UC Berkeley, and EAP (if appropriate) requirements and policies, as well as with the requirements of the host university. I understand that failure to comply with the appropriate rules and procedures may affect my UC and EAP status, as well as my Haas degree progress and status in the program. Important requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:

- All business courses must be completed for letter grades.
- Students going abroad during the academic year must enroll each semester in at least 13 UC-transferable semester units (or the EAP minimum). This enrollment must be pre-approved by the Haas international study advisor.
