They started with something basic: socks with soul, altruistic underwear, and other everyday essentials made with fabrics that feel good and go easy on the environment.

Each season, PACT designs a new collection of clothing inspired by someone doing something good: whether it's about clean water, sustainable food, or affordable housing. PACT also promotes sustainable textiles, fair trade and fair labor, regional manufacturing, and environmental responsibility to operate the most sustainable supply chain possible. No matter what PACT does, they always stay true to their basic principles. Good design. Good fabric. Good cause.

For PACT's Spring 2013 campaign, they have partnered with Indiegogo (another successful Haas business) and the Whole Kids Foundation on a program that will crowdfund \$250,000 to build 100 urban gardens across America.
