The Center for Responsible Business tries to create a more sustainable, ethical and socially responsible society by establishing the Haas School of Business as the preeminent educational institution for research, teaching, experiential learning, and community outreach in areas of corporate social responsibility. We look forward to the opportunity to partner with the Haas School of Business Ph.D. Program to provide substantial research contributions to the nascent field of Corporate Social Responsibility.

This research based fellowship will focus on one of the three substantive areas of Corporate Social Responsibility the Center for Responsible Business is pursuing: corporate engagement and governance, social enterprise, and social performance metrics.

Application Requirements and Process:

- Students from all Haas School of Business Ph.D. program areas (Accounting, Business and Public Policy, Finance, Marketing, Organizational Behavior, Real Estate) are eligible to apply for the Fellowship.
- An applicant must have a faculty advisor for their research.
- Please submit a 2-5 page double-spaced application briefly outlining the research you would focus on by **Friday, May 27th, 2005** to the Haas School of Business Ph.D. Program Office. Please briefly motivate your question, describe your research methods and data (if relevant), and explain why the answer matters.
- Please include a faculty sponsor letter of recommendation and a copy of your CV.
- Include details of how your work would complement and benefit the work of the Center for Responsible Business.
